Swimming Pool Rules 2023

SAFETY FIRST! OBEY the Lifeguards at ALL times. Our Guards have the authority to enforce the following rules without question.

1. **Children must be at least 9 years of age** to be eligible to swim without adult supervision having passed a mandatory swim test. The test will be at the discretion of the Lifeguards, usually one length of the pool and treading water for 1 minute.

2. **Children must be 13 years old to supervise other children**

3. **Rubber Pants** must be worn without exception by children wearing diapers, swim diapers, or otherwise not “toilet trained.” Harmful bacteria including e-coli are associated with all types of diapers. Sick children symptomatic of diarrhea should not swim within 24 hours of ill. **This is a Health Department Law!**

4. Children wearing **Flotation Devices** such as “swimmies”, “water-wings”, “bubbles”, lifeguard jackets, etc. are not allowed in the deep end without adult supervision. Adults supervising children using these devices must be in the water with the child, not on the deck. Children with flotation devices may not use the slide without direct parental supervision i.e. at the discharge area of the slide.

5. **The Baby Pool is not supervised by a Lifeguard. Therefore, parental supervision is required at all times.** The Baby Pool is intended for children 5 years and younger. If crowding becomes an issue, the Lifeguards may ask children over 5 years of age to leave the Baby Pool. Use of water toys such as water guns needs to be monitored by the parent. If it becomes a problem, lifeguards may ban such toys from the baby pool.

6. **Guests** are permitted in the pool area only with the inviting resident. Residents are responsible for the actions of their guests. This is not applicable to parties. Refer to Rule #26 for further information. Please contact the Pool Manager for any questions that may arise.

7. **Weather** related issues will be addressed by the Lifeguards. If lightning is observed, the pool and surrounding area will be evacuated. When thunder is heard, only the pool will be evacuated. Swimming may resume after a minimum 45 minutes of clear conditions. When weather related conditions occur during the last hour of pool operations, the pool will close for the remainder of the day.

Due to poor weather conditions, the pool may close for the day. You may contact the pool at 704.875.9641 for verification.

8. **Telephone usage** is restricted to contacting parents and emergencies. Calls are limited to a

minimum of 3 minutes enforceable by the Lifeguards. No personal calls are permitted.



9. **Diving** is not permitted outside the diving well. If you are unclear, then check with a Lifeguard. No back dives or front/back flips are permitted at the pool!

10. **Pool Toys** may be used at the discretion of the Lifeguards. Crowded conditions may prohibit the use on some pool toys. Large floats may only be used when the pool is not crowded. Neither towels nor non pool related items (coins, paper, cans, etc.) are permitted in the pool at any time.

11. **Adult Swim** time will be recognized for 10 minutes every hour.

No one under 18 years of age will be permitted in the pool during this time. The Lifeguards will announce this period.

12. **Lap Swimming** is permitted when the pool is not crowded.

13. **Safety** comes first at our pool. Running, pushing, wrestling, and other unsafe “horseplay” will NOT be permitted. No “leap frog” games are allowed in the deep end. No hanging on the lane ropes is allowed. No wheels (wheelies) on pool deck.

14. **Food and drinks** are permitted in the pool area. However, please clean up after yourself so as to discourage unwelcome insects. Absolutely no glass is permitted.

15. **Alcoholic beverages** are permitted in the pool area. However, persons under the influence of alcohol or “other” intoxicants can be denied pool access.

16. **Smoking and tobacco** use is NOT permitted on any Wynfield property.

17. **Noise** levels should be kept to a minimum. Personal radios and other portable electronic devices are permitted only with the use of head or earphones. A radio is permitted on the Guard House Counter. However, the volume must be reasonably maintained.

18. North Carolina State Law mandates that no one is permitted in an **unguarded pool and surrounding pool area**, without the presence of a Lifeguard. In compliance, the Wynfield Homeowners Association has authorized the Huntersville Police Department to strictly enforce this law. Violators will be expelled for the remainder of the pool season.

19. **Fraternalizing and socializing** with the Lifeguards, especially the ones working on the “stands” is not permitted.

20. **Pets or companion animals** with the exception of certified seeing-eye dogs are not permitted in both the pool and the pool area.

21. **Personal Cleanliness** is held in the highest regard. Please be considerate and shower prior to swimming. Encourage your children to use the facilities provided at the pool. Only swimsuits and

appropriate pool clothing is permitted. No “street clothes” including cut-offs will be permitted.



22. **Facility Cleanliness** is essential. Please deposit trash in the appropriate identified locations. Trashcans are located in convenient locations on the pool deck. A recycling bin is also available for cans. All food & drink is prohibited in the pool. No gum or spitting will be tolerated. Please be considerate by using sports bottles and similar containers so as to prevent and contain potential spills.

23. **Communicable Issues** can prevent admission to the pool. Anyone having infectious diseases, excessive sunburn, open wounds, bandages, chicken pox, conjunctivitis (pink eye), nasal discharge, ear discharge, will be denied access to the pool. The health department states that such issues compromise water cleanliness and potentially harm other persons in the pool.

24. **Rule Enforcement** is the responsibility of the Lifeguards and Pool Manager. At the discretion of the Lifeguards and Pool Manager, violators may be prohibited from using the pool for the remaining day or for the remaining summer swim season. Swim Team members will also be subjective to disciplinary issues by their coaches.

25. The following identifies general actions taken by the Lifeguards, Pool Manager or Swim Team Coach:

1st violation: Expulsion from pool for remainder of day and Parental notification. 2nd violation: 5 day denied pool access and documented notification to the Wynfield Board of Directors.

3rd violation: Permanent expulsion from pool for the remainder of the season. Anyone violating North Carolina Law will be turned over to the Huntersville Police Department.

26. **Pool Parties** will be coordinated by the Pool Management Company. Parties less than approximately 8 people will be allowed during regular pool hours only after appropriate notification provided to the Pool Management Company at least one week in advance regardless if the party members live within the community. Parties of more than 8 people will need to be scheduled through the Pool Manager after regular pool hours. Children’s parties will require at least one parent per every 5 children in addition to the regularly scheduled lifeguards. Parties having up to approximately 40 guests will require a minimum of 2 Lifeguards. Parties exceeding 40 guests will require additional Lifeguards. All parties are responsible for the clean-up and any associated damaged resulting from their event.

For Further information on parties, please contact the Wynfield Pool Management Company. Certain “black-out” dates may apply. Absolutely no parties are to be held during the weekends of Memorial Day, Labor Day, and the 4th of July holidays.
